For Free DIAPERS:

Families must bring with them a "WIC" card to show proof of need.

One package per child, per visit, per month.

Diapers are only released to the parents or legal guardians of a child.

Proof of Residence:

Families must be residents of Lincoln County.

Proof of residency must be provided to receive free diapers. All other services are free.

The following are acceptable examples of proof of residency:

- Driver's license or Photo ID (with current address)
- MRecent utility receipt
- Piece of recent mail with current address
- Note from landlord (if in hotel) with date, signature, and phone contact for landlord.
